Westport Country Playhouse Features Two Out Gay Men in Staging of "The Importance of Being Earnest" by Gay Literary Icon Oscar Wilde

Openly gay actors Michael Raver and Anthony Michael Martinez are cast in the comedy classic, playing October 28 – November 15

Westport, CT –Westport Country Playhouse will stage the witty, timeless classic, "The Importance of Being Earnest," by the gay literary icon Oscar Wilde, from October 28 through November 15. Two openly gay actors are cast in leading roles: Michael Raver as Jack Worthing, the respectable bachelor leading a double life; and Anthony Michael Martinez as Algernon Moncrieff, the witty idler whose "Bunburying" sets the farcical machinations in motion. The Westport production reunites Wilde's sparkling satire of Victorian society with a modern-minded cast and a fresh, spirited staging by director Melissa Rain Anderson.

"Oscar Wilde—his brilliant epigrams, his daring life, his identity as an out gay man in the late 19th century—stands as a major figure in literary and LGBTQ+ history," said Raver. "In choosing Wilde's work, and by centering his legacy through inclusive casting, the Playhouse honors both his artistry and his courage.

"With two out gay men headlining this production of a play by one of the great gay literary icons, the Playhouse affirms the enduring relevance of Wilde's satirical voice, challenging conventions of gender, class, and identity with delightfully caustic wit," said Raver. "The casting invites us to recognize that farce, society, and self-invention are intertwined, and enriches the text, not by rewriting it, but by honoring its subtext and legacy."

The eight-actor ensemble brings crisp comedic timing and elegant style to Wilde's razor-sharp dialogue. In addition to Raver and Martinez, the cast includes Kristen Hahn as Cecily Cardew, Jan Neuberger as Miss Prism, Christine Pedi as Lady Bracknell, Triney Sandoval as Rev. Canon Chasuble, D.D., Mark Silence as Merriman, Lane, and Katy Tang as Gwendolyn Fairfax.

Wilde's beloved comedy—mistaken identities, secret engagements, a lost handbag, and one very formidable aunt—wears its Victorian trappings with gleeful irreverence. "This staging elevates the visual world into a more relaxed Edwardian-era palette, allowing the language and the performances to fly," added Raver.

Playwright Oscar Wilde (1854-1900) remains one of the most brilliant and defiant voices of the late Victorian age. As a playwright, essayist and poet, he armed himself with a razor-sharp wit and a penchant for social critique. As an out gay man in an era of legal and cultural hostility, his life and work resonate deeply in the LGBTQ+ community and beyond.
