THE POSITION

Westport Country Playhouse seeks personable, customer-minded, and confident individuals to work in the concessions stand. Job responsibilities include restocking concession items if necessary, selling food and beverages (including alcohol) pre-show and during intermission, and keeping an accurate inventory and records of daily sales.

Concessions staff must maintain high sanitation/hygiene practices and adhere to the concessions dress code. At the end of each shift, concessions staff will reconcile sales and inventory and report sales to the House Manager.
